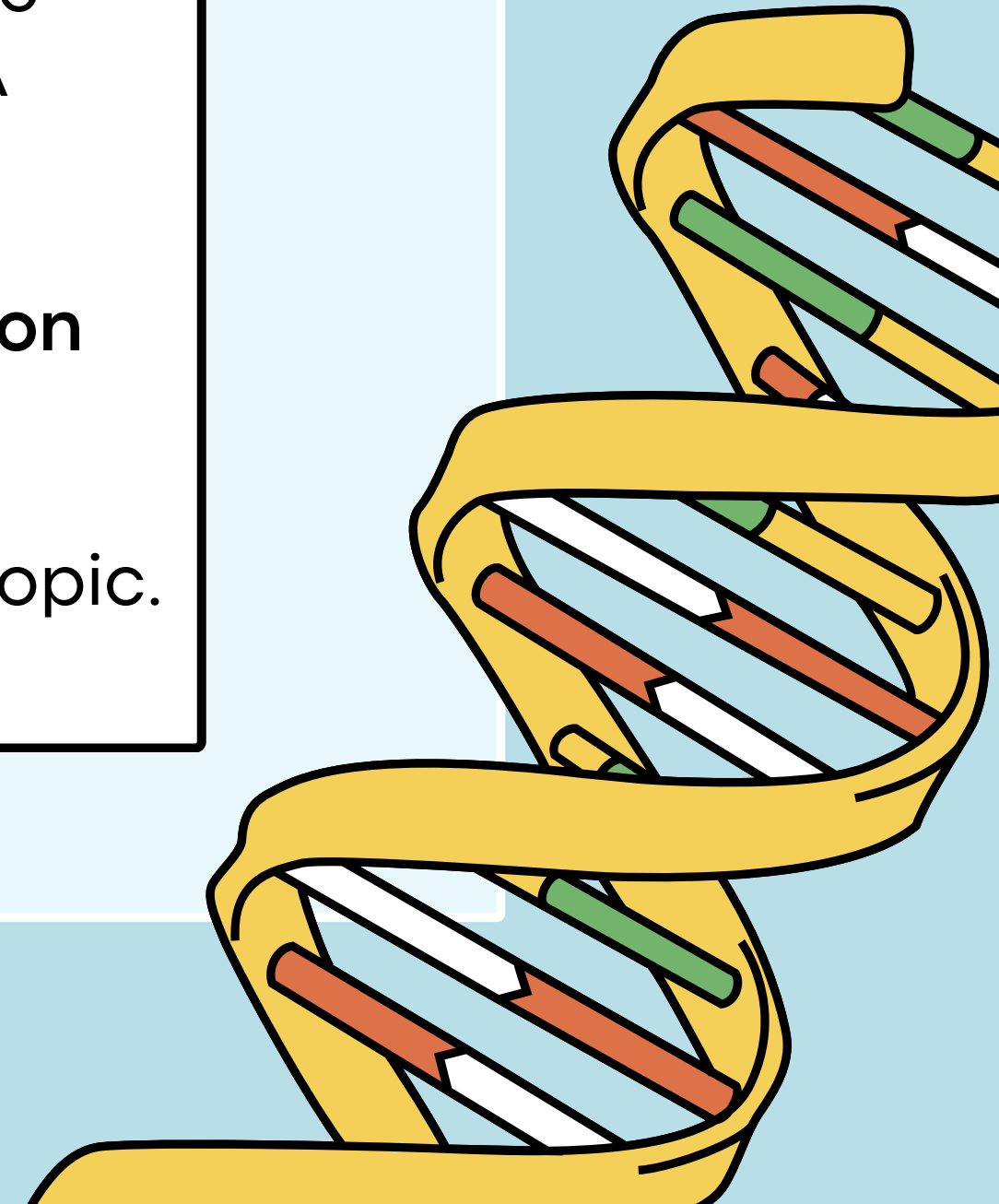
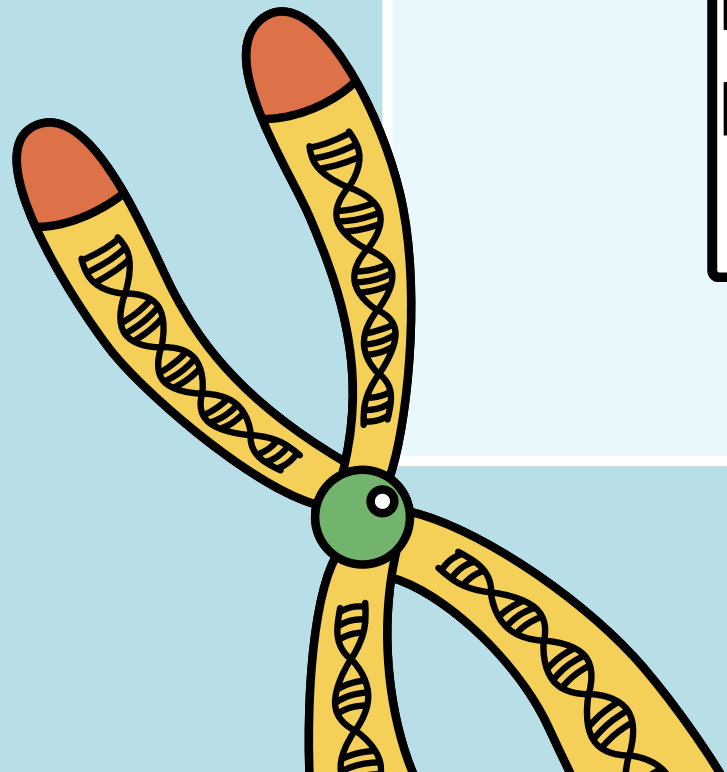
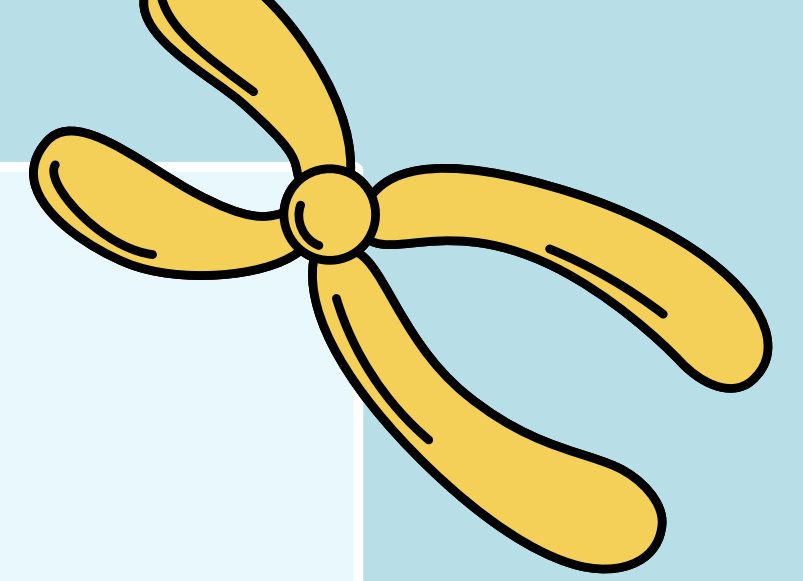


DNA Testing for UK Visa and Immigration Applications – What You Need to Know

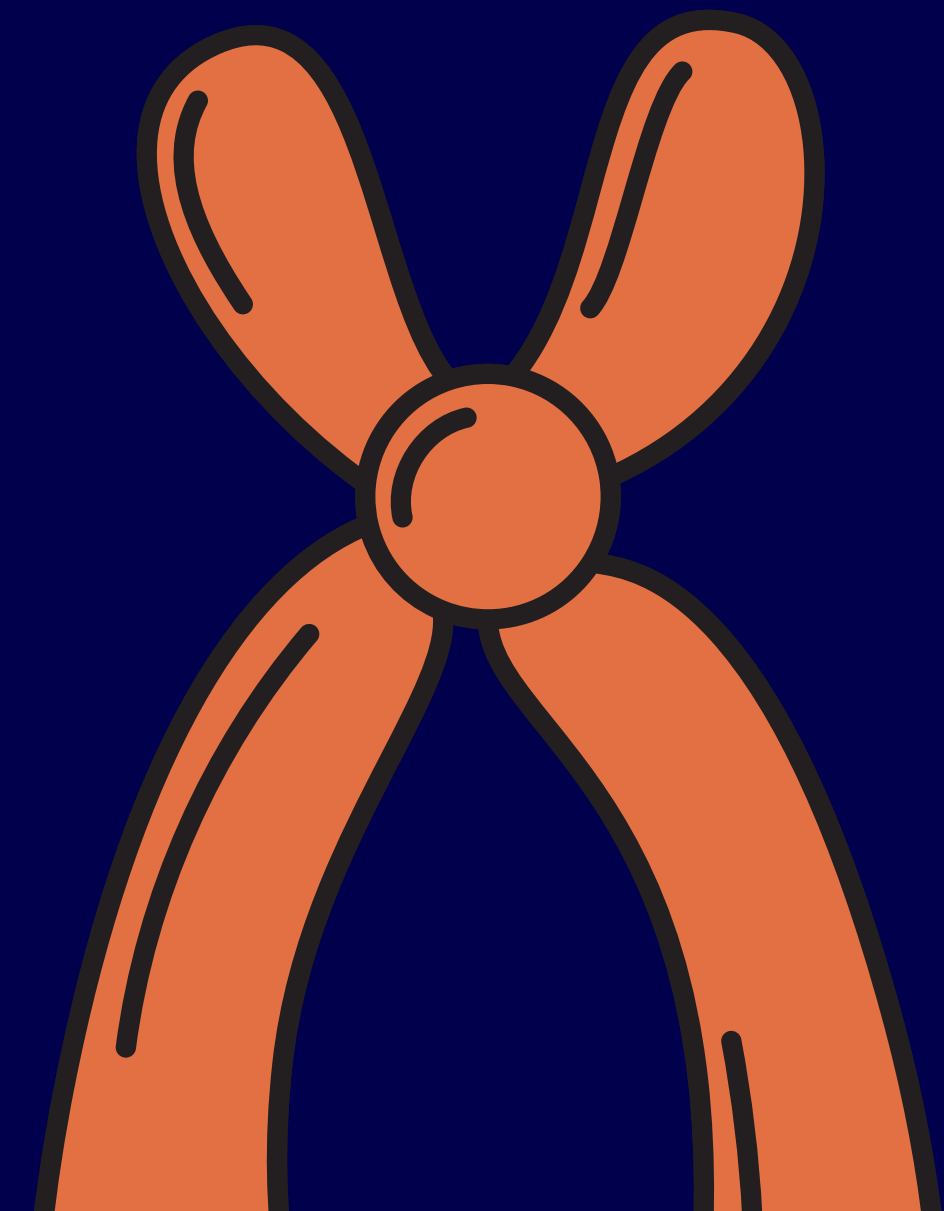


Who might want a DNA Test for Immigration/Passport Applications?

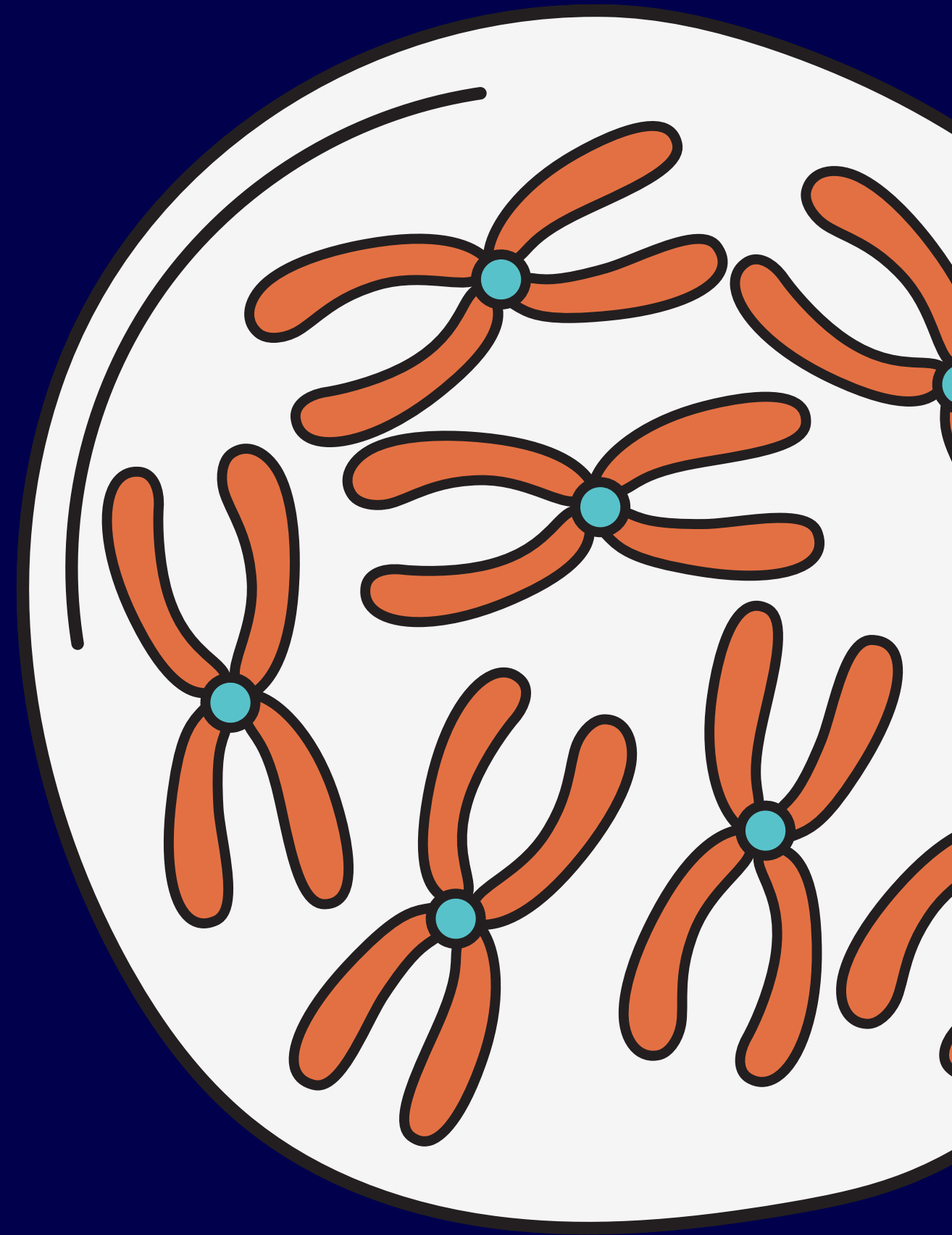


Parent-Child Relationships:

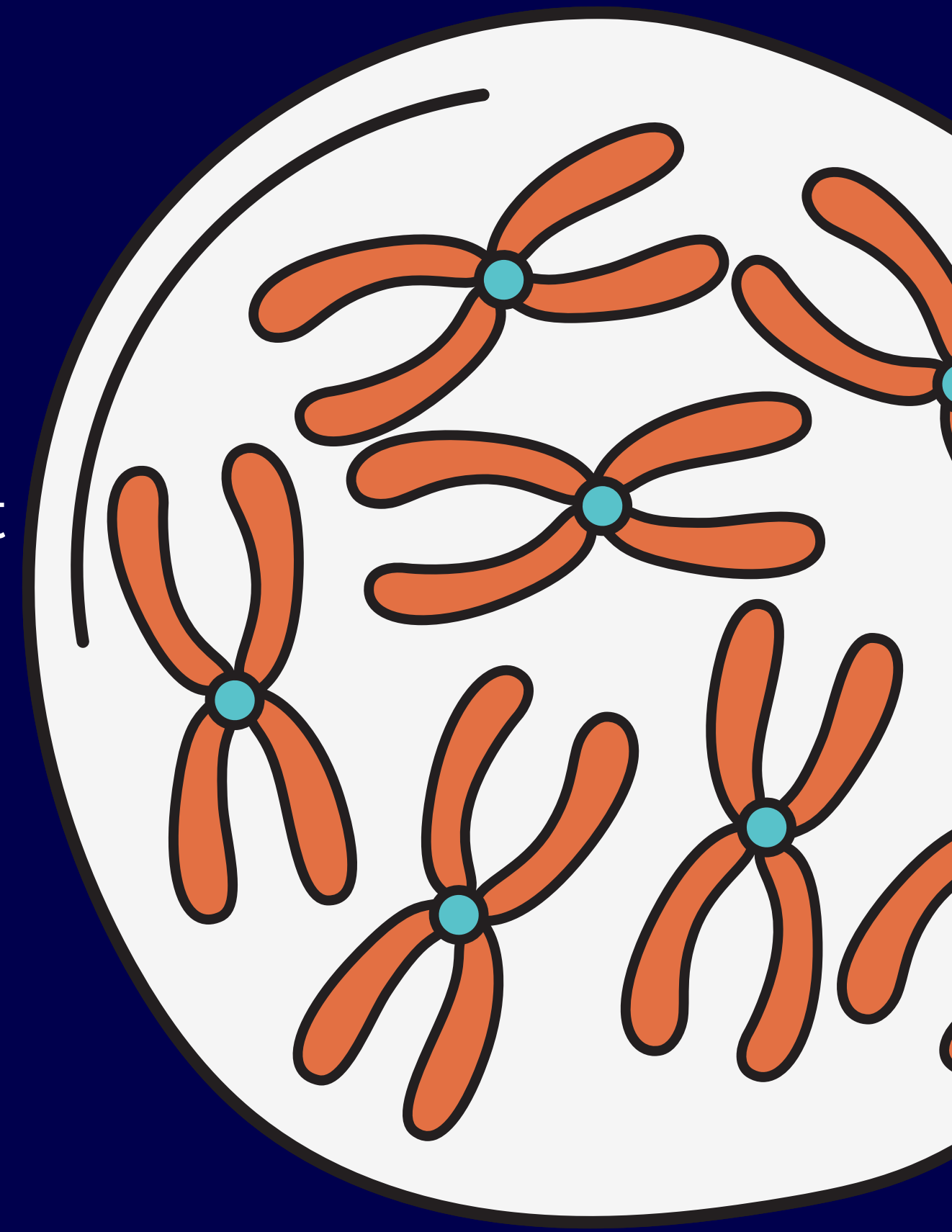


Grandparentage DNA Tests
